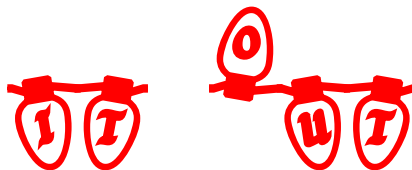

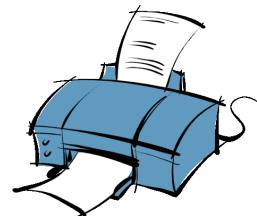
Demonstration will be held in the Community Room and provide a general introduction to accessing Wisconsin's Digital Library and, as time permits, other resources.
