WHEREAS, there are more than 40,000 professional land surveyors in the United States;
and

WHEREAS, the nature of surveying has changed dramatically since the Colonial Era when the profession was defined by the description and location of land boundaries; today, surveying has expanded to include engineering surveys to utilize in the study and selection of engineering construction, geodetic surveys to determine precise global positioning for military and civilian activities, cartographic surveys used for mapping and charting; and

WHEREAS, professional surveyors provide important services through the use of sophisticated equipment and techniques, such as satellite-borne remote sensing devices, and automated positioning, measuring, recording and plotting equipment; and


WHEREAS, the role of the surveyor has been, and continues to be integral in the development and advancement of our municipalities, our state, and our nation; and
