WHEREAS, the City of Brookfield recognizes the importance of sustainability, and articulated this goal in its 2035 Comprehensive Plan, as follows, "Brookfield is a sustainable community in all aspects - from the environment to the economy - and leads in responsible community growth and redevelopment"; and
