Chapter 5.32 PRECIOUS METALS DEALERS

5.32.010 Purpose.

Gold and other precious metals and stones continue substantially to increase in value. The theft thereof is a growing and serious problem. The council's intent is to deter such illegal activity by making it difficult to dispose of such stolen items. The licensing and regulating of dealers in secondhand gold and other precious metals and stones is in the public interest. (Prior code § 12.18(1))

5.32.020 License required.

No person shall engage in the business of purchasing secondhand gold, other precious metals, and stones without obtaining a license from the city clerk. Application forms shall be provided by the clerk and shall contain the name of the applicant, his home and business address, the names and addresses of all employees, and a statement listing any past conviction or pending arrest record for offenses relating to theft, burglary, possession of stolen property, or other crimes relating to property. The license fee shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per year. Applications shall be referred to the police department for investigation and report. (Prior code § 12.18(2))

5.32.030 Records required.

Every dealer involved in the purchase of secondhand gold, silver, precious stones or other precious metals or stones, or articles containing the same, shall, within twenty-four (24) hours after receiving such article, report to the chief of police that it has been received, with the name, address and description of the person from whom received and a description of such article. No dealer shall destroy, alter or dispose of such article until fifteen (15) days after making his report to the chief of police. Section 134.71, Wisconsin Statutes, is incorporated herein by reference. (Prior code § 12.18(3))

5.32.040 Revocation or suspension.

Any dealer is subject to having his license suspended or revoked for violations of this section, or upon conviction of purchasing stolen goods, fraud or misrepresentation. The licensee shall be entitled to a hearing before the license committee after notice thereof and shall have the right to counsel. The committee's decision shall be final unless appealed to the Circuit Court of Waukesha County within ten days by petition for writ of certiorari. (Prior code § 12.18(4))

5.32.050 Violation--Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions hereof shall be subject to the penalties provided in Chapter 1.12. (Prior code § 12.18(5))
