LILLY HEIGHTS PARK

Acreage: 34

Lilly Heights Park is a 34 acre partially developed neighborhood/regional park located in the northeastern portion of the City and includes a parcel of undeveloped land located adjacent to, and northwest of, the currently developed site. The site also encompasses wetlands within the primary environmental corridor along Butler Ditch. Most of the land (29 acres) was dedicated to the City for parkland in 1980 as part of the Lilly Heights subdivision development.
