Lilly Road – Off Road Pedestrian Pathway

To: North Avenue

Council Chambers - City Hall, 2000 N. Calhoun Road

This letter is to inform you of the City's plans to install an asphalt pedestrian pathway along the east side of Lilly Road from Hidden Lake Park south to North Avenue. This proposed pathway is anticipated to be separated from the roadway and will be constructed within the Lilly Road Right-of-Way (ROW). No easements or other interests from private property are anticipated. The City is currently developing preliminary plans and will have them available for viewing at the Public Information Meeting.

Construction of this pathway includes tree removal (as needed), excavation, storm sewer, stone placement, asphalt pavement and turf restoration which is scheduled to commence by July be completed by October 2023. The City strives to provide a safe pathway while preserving high quality tree species and landscaping by designing a pathway that meanders to minimize these impacts.

As a property owner adjacent to this project, you are invited to attend a **Public Information Meeting** to be held at the **Council Chambers within the City Hall, 2000 N. Calhoun Road, on Monday, January 23, 2023**. When available, the plans will be viewable online via the City's website <http://www.ci.brookfield.wi.us> (see under Latest News).
