



MINUTES FOR THE City of Brookfield MUNICIPAL BOARD OF CANVASSERS
HELD ON FEBRUARY 21, 2020, AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS,
CITY HALL, 2000 N. CALHOUN ROAD, BROOKFIELD, WISCONSIN

Election: February 18, 2020

City Clerk Michaels called the meeting to order at 4:07 p.m. Kelly Michaels stated that a provisional ballot was received on Election Day in Ward 8 by the voter Maureen MacVane, 3360 San Marcos Drive, due to the fact that the voter could not provide Photo ID. She had until 4:00 p.m. today (February 21st) to show her photo ID in order for her ballot to be counted. The voter did not provide photo to the Clerk by that deadline. The provisional ballot bag will not be processed (not rehabilitated). Therefore, the provisional ballot was rejected due to the fact that the voter could not provide Photo ID by 4:00 p.m. February 21, 2020.

The Board then canvassed the results for District 3 Alderman. The Board read the results from the final tapes of Wards 8, 9, and 10 and verified them against the Tabular Statement of Total Votes Cast prepared by the City Clerk as follows:

Ron Balzer received 332 votes
Jenna Meza received 315 votes
Gregory Keller received 150 votes
