

ORDINANCE NO. 2295-12

**RESCINDING PORTIONS OF THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF ORDINANCE NO. 460,
AUTHORIZING OPERATION OF A DUMP ON LANDS CURRENTLY PLATTED IN PART
AS THE SHIRE OR APPROVED FOR PLATTING AS THE SHIRE ADDITION NO. 1, BUT
EXCLUDING LANDS CURRENTLY OWNED AND MANAGED BY WASTE
MANAGEMENT**

WHEREAS, on May 21, 1968, the Common Council adopted Ordinance No. 460, granting a conditional use for Acme Disposal Service Corporation to operate a dump at 1365 N. Brookfield Road; and

WHEREAS, the lands to be removed from Ordinance No. 460 are currently platted in part as The Shire or approved for platting as The Shire Addition No. 1, but excludes those lands currently owned and managed by Waste Management; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Brookfield do ordain as follows:

PART I. To rescind portions of the geographic area of Ordinance No. 460, approved on May 21, 1968, authorizing operation of a dump on lands currently platted in part as The Shire or approved for platting as The Shire Addition No. 1, but excluding lands currently owned and managed by Waste Management, which will remain under regulation of Ordinance No. 460, the legal description of the lands removed from Ordinance No 460 being:

Part of the Southeast ¼ of Section 20, Town 7 North, Range 20 East, City of Brookfield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin excluding Outlots 1 and 2 of Certified Survey Map No. 9898 being a redivision of a part of Parcel 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 4238, being a part of the Northeast ¼ and Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 29; also a redivision of a part of Parcel 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 4178, being a part of the Southeast ¼ and Southwest ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 20, all in Township 7 North, Range 20 east, in the City of Brookfield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
