

Germany Romantic Road Tour

Munich, Rothenburg, Wurzburg, Seligenstadt.

July 10-21, 2015

The Brookfield Sister Cities Committee, the Brookfield International Friendship Association, Inc., and Mayor Steve Ponto invite you to travel to Germany to join our friends from Seligenstadt, the “Blessed City” on a tour of southern Germany’s famous Romantic Road.

We’ll spend four days exploring Munich and it’s neighboring area. Then we’re off to medieval Rothenburg on the “Romantic Road” to explore the town’s historic sites overlooking the Tauber River. Next, we’ll travel to scenic Wurzburg in the Franconia region of northern Bavaria known for its wine. Finally, we will arrive in our sister city Seligenstadt and view beautiful historic buildings.



A special highlight of the trip will be joining our friends in the Geleitsfest activities and the cities 1200th anniversary celebration. Geleitsfest celebrates Seligenstadt’s historic role in the merchant trade to Frankfurt. This event is held every four years. Our visit will culminate in an official reception at City Hall with a spectacular evening “Main in Flammen” where flaming floats on barges will proceed up the Main River.

Estimated cost is \$3,275 per person* including airfare, lodging, bus travel, breakfast and guided tours. Deadline for reservations is February 28, 2015. A \$500 deposit is required.
