

# Mayor's Proclamation

- WHEREAS, The Muscular Dystrophy Association (“MDA”) is a non-profit organization which combats muscular dystrophy and diseases of the nervous system and the muscular system by funding research, providing medical services and educating the public; and
- WHEREAS, MDA funds approximately 200 research projects in twelve countries and provides best-in-class, comprehensive care at more than 150 MDA Care Centers; and
- WHEREAS, Funds raised for MDA provide comprehensive medical services and vital research for over 1,300 families in Southern Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, In the Greater Milwaukee Area, MDA funds support outpatient clinics at Children’s and Froedtert Hospitals, and the Wisconsin MDA Summer Camp; and
- WHEREAS, Through the support of the local business community and concerned citizens over \$265,000 has been raised for MDA in Brookfield since 2010; and
- WHEREAS, Through the MDA Lock-Up being held today at Blackfinn Ameripub in Brookfield, business and community leaders agree to be “locked up” while they raise money for the “bail,” which helps bring more everyday freedoms to kids and adults with muscular dystrophy, ALS and related diseases that take away physical strength and mobility.
