 - iii. Evidence sufficient to demonstrate that the pole or tower, due to its height and size, poses no greater danger to the health, safety, and welfare of the public than existing poles or towers in nearby right-of-way.

d. A structural analysis stamped by a professional engineer licensed in Wisconsin.

All work in connection therewith will be done in a workmanlike manner...
Permittee will refill all trenches with material as specified herein...
All trenches in the surfaced section of an improved street or pavement...
The remaining top 14" of the trench shall be restored as follows:
Main Roadways - the trench shall be filled with 8" of compacted crushed stone...
Secondary Roadways - the trench shall be filled with 10" of compacted crushed stone...
Secondary Roadways with deep lift asphalt - the trench shall be brought to within 7" of the existing surface...
Excavations beyond 5 feet from the edge of pavement but within the limits of the street...
If the person holding the permit fails to restore the pavement to its original condition...
After installation of said mains, laterals, line and supply routes, revised location plans shall be submitted to the Engineer...
If this box is checked there are additional or specific conditions for this permit - see separate sheet.
