



High School Hoops Manager Memo

PRIOR TO THE SEASON

- Park & Rec. provides game basketball only **teams provide basketballs for practice.**
- Team practices can begin the week of **January 4, 2021.**
- With limited gyms available, teams will practice every other week, one week on, one week off.
- Last date to add members to your team: **January 29, 2021.**

COVID-19

- Face coverings are required inside all school district facilities at all times. This includes during practices and games. Failure to properly wear a face covering will result in removal from the game/facility. Player conduct violations outlined in [section VII](#) of the league rules will be followed to determine consequences for non-mask compliance. Please wear a mask.
- No spectators will be allowed at games. One volunteer scorekeeper (required) and one volunteer to live stream the game (optional) is allowed per team. A maximum of three (3) coaches are permitted on the team bench. All coaches must have a signed copy of the coach Code of Conduct on file.

GAME DAY REMINDERS

- Buildings open no earlier than 7:45am on game day
- All teams must be coached and supervised at all times by an adult, 21 years of age or older, both at games and practices.
- All teams must supply an adult **score keeper** to work each game at the score table
- No jewelry of any kind may be worn during basketball games. Jewelry cannot be covered with tape -it must be removed. Jewelry –Casts-Hair Accessories-All exposed items that are judged hazardous or potentially dangerous by the referee may not be worn during the game. This includes, but is not limited to, casts, splints, wristwatches, large rings, bracelets, neck chains, hair accessories or earrings that extend below the ear lobe.
- **No DUNKING**, hanging or touching the rim. Not at practice, not during pre-game warm-ups, not at halftime, not during the game, no dunking allowed anytime. Violation will result in (2) technical fouls and an automatic ejection. Please do not dunk.
- Forfeit fee = \$30, two forfeits in one season = removal from the league.

- Ejection from the game for any reason results in an automatic suspension for the next scheduled regular season or playoff game.
- **Games will NOT be rescheduled to accommodate teams with players not available on scheduled dates.** We do not have any openings to facilitate a re-schedule. The dates on the schedule are the dates and times referees, staff and gyms are scheduled/reserved. If teams want to trade spots with each other on the current schedule, we can allow a switch. In that case all teams involved need to confirm the switch in writing (email).
- All players on the official line-up sheet must be registered with **THAT** team. Players from other teams may **NOT** be added for the purpose of having sufficient players for the game.

JERSEYS

- Teams must have similar colored shirts with numbers on the back, written or **taped #'s are not allowed.**
- All team names and artwork on jerseys must use appropriate language and imagery or they will not be allowed. If you are unsure if a design or wording is appropriate please contact the department with your artist proof before purchasing jerseys.
