



CITY OF BROOKFIELD VOTING OPTIONS

2020 GENERAL ELECTION (Presidential)

The ballot that fits your timeline (evenings or weekends, you decide)!

Mail Ballots: If you are ill or at high risk for COVID-19, we highly encouraged this option. The request must be received in writing either online (MyVote), email or a paper written request. Your ballot will be mailed to the address of your choice within one business day. Wisconsin has a Photo ID law, so be sure to **attach a copy of your Photo ID** along with your request for a ballot. Voted ballots must be returned to us by no later than Election Day in order to be counted! Don't delay in requesting or returning your ballot.

We anticipate ballots to be available for mailing on or near Thursday, September 17, 2020! Requests for ballots are being accepted now! The deadline to request a mail ballot is Thursday, October 29th, 2020.

RETURNING YOUR MAIL BALLOT:

- USPS mail return: The ballot must be received back by no later than Election Day in order to count. The Postal Service advises at least 2-5 days for local delivery and longer for out of the area delivery.
- Drop off return: You may deliver your ballot to the Clerk's Office at City Hall during regular business hours (2000 North Calhoun Road, Brookfield WI 53005) (the "return to address" is listed on the envelope). Our regular business hours are M-F, 8am-5pm. On Election Day we are open 7am., to 8 pm., and ballots may be dropped off up until 8:00 pm.
- **DROP BOX RETURN:** You may drop your absentee ballot enclosed inside the completed return envelope, into the Payment Drop Box located on the east side parking lot that runs between the back of City Hall and Brookfield Central High School at any time between now and 8:00 pm., on Election Day. The drop box is checked daily and on Election Day it is checked multiple times during the day with the last check at 8:00 pm.

TRACKING YOUR MAIL BALLOT:

Your mail ballot has a barcode to track its delivery and return. Go to the MyVote system and use the MyVoterInfo tab to view the status of your absentee ballot.

Absentee ballots are NOT processed at the polling locations. They are processed at a Central Count Location on Election Day (Brookfield Conference Center, 385 S Moorland Rd). If you have any questions regarding your absentee ballot, please contact the City Clerk's Office at (262) 782-9650. We are your best source for information concerning your registration or ballot.

MAIL BALLOT ENVELOPES ARE INSPECTED FOR THE FOLLOWING BY ELECTION INSPECTORS IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED:

- **Voter Signature Required:** Sign the ballot envelope where it indicates Voter Signature.
- **Witness Signature Required:** Any US Citizen can sign as your witness including spouses, adult children, neighbors and friends. If you don't have a witness to sign, we encourage you to vote in-person.
- **Witness Address Required:** Even if the address is the same as yours, you must include the witness address.
- **Evidence of Tampering:** **DON'T TAPE YOUR ENVELOPE!** Election Inspectors will view that as evidence that your envelope was opened and resealed as a tampering event and will reject your ballot. Please use a damp cloth or glue stick to seal your ballot envelope.

Once you have returned an absentee ballot, you may **NOT** vote at the polls. If you have questions or concerns regarding your absentee ballot, please contact the City Clerk's Office at (262) 782-9650.

In-person Absentee Voting at City Hall – (Acceptable Photo ID Required)

In-Person Absentee Ballots: This option is available to voters who are unable or unwilling to vote at their polling location on Election Day and/or those who prefer not to receive a mailed ballot. Please be aware: there may be lines at times! Due to Covid-19, social distancing and safe protocols will be in place. Please wear a mask.
