

**BROOKFIELD PARKS, RECREATION & FORESTRY DEPARTMENT: 2021 SEASON**  
**HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL LEAGUE: GRADES 9-10**  
**HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL LEAGUE: GRADES 11-12**

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- **Open to residents of the Elmbrook School District and students attending the Elmbrook School District.**
- Players must presently be enrolled in Grade 9 through 12.
- A player may not play in this league if they have been a member of their high school squad during the current season.

**TEAM ORGANIZATION:**

- Players form their own teams. **A minimum of 10 players per team is required.**
- Team registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis to a maximum of 12 teams in each league. Teams attempting to register after limit of 12 has been reached will be placed on a waiting list and entered on a space available basis to round out the league.
- All teams **must be coached and supervised at all times by an adult, 21 years of age or older.**
- Boys teams may have up to 2 girls on the team. Girls' teams may have up to 2 boys on the team.
- **Individual players looking for teams:** Single players may submit their names to the Parks and Recreation office for potential placement on teams, however, team placement cannot be guaranteed.

**LEAGUE SCHEDULE:**

- Girls league will be formed if enough teams in grades 9 – 12 enroll (6).
- Teams will be divided into divisions prior to the season if there are enough teams.
- Practices and regular season games will be scheduled on weeknights and/or on Saturdays (8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.) in Elmbrook School District facilities from January through March. (Depending on league alignment and length of schedule, post-season playoffs may be held.)

**LEAGUE FEES:**

- Player registration fee of **\$70** per player for City of Brookfield residents, **\$105** for Elmbrook School District students not residing within the City of Brookfield, and **\$140** for students living outside of either the City of Brookfield or the Elmbrook School District.
- Resident and non-resident player fees and player rosters are due when registering the team.
- Once paid, all fees are NOT refundable or transferable.
- All checks should be made payable to "Brookfield Parks and Recreation Dept."
- Team roster forms, if not attached, are available at the Parks and Recreation Office or from the Athletic Director's office at your school.
- Teams that forfeit must pay a \$20.00 forfeit fee before they are allowed to play in another game.

**REGISTRATION:**

- Registrations will be accepted beginning **October 26– November 20, 2020** at the Parks and Recreation office, 2000 N. Calhoun Road. Office hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. All registration is in person ONLY.
- Teams are advised that maximum registration may be received before November 20. Early registration is encouraged.
- ALL fees must be paid when registering.
- Team Roster Form must be signed by the manager and completed when registering.
- All (minimum of 10) "Player Registration Forms" must be completed for each player, signed, and submitted when registering.
- **Note: The last date to add players to teams in this league is Friday, January 29, 2021.**

**PRACTICES:**

- The Parks & Recreation Dept. has reserved gym time for team practices at various schools. This time will be divided between the teams at the league organizational meeting. **Teams are advised that limited practice time will be available.** Depending on gym availability it is probable that there may not be practice every week. **Practices must be supervised at all times by an adult, 21 years of age or older.**

**UNIFORMS:**

- Teams need not have full uniforms; however, teams **must** have similarly colored reversible shirts or jerseys with numbers on the back, **taped #'s are not allowed.** Players must purchase their own individual team jersey with a number. Duplicate numbers are not allowed. Legal numbers include: 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, and 55. Any other number will not be allowed. All team names and artwork on jerseys must use appropriate language and imagery or it will not be allowed. Player names must be the actual name as registered. Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to not allow a uniform with inappropriate language to be used.
