The Parks and Recreation Commission has initiated the planning process for the development of a neighborhood park at the Imperial site located in Section 4 of the City. A planning committee consisting of local residents was appointed by the District Alderpersons to work with City staff to establish a Master Plan for the park to guide future development and improvements. Over the past several weeks, the Committee has been considering alternative park plan concepts with City staff and consultants with the result of this process culminating in a draft master plan which has been preliminarily recommended by the Committee.

Interested residents will have an opportunity to review and provide comment regarding the Master Plan over the next several weeks to include a Public Open Forum and Plan Review as indicated above. The forum will be conducted in an open house format and interested individuals are welcome to attend anytime between the hours of 5:30-7:30 p.m. The draft master plan, background information, and related exhibits will be displayed and there will be an opportunity to ask questions, exchange information and offer suggestions regarding the plan with Committee members and City Staff. In addition, the Parks and Recreation Commission will receive public comment pertaining to the proposed plan and recommended improvements as part of their regular meeting on Monday, July 18th, 7:00 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers at City Hall.
