## CALHOUN ROAD TO CLOSE LONG-TERM

The City of Brookfield, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is scheduled to begin reconstruction of Calhoun Road between North Avenue and Capitol Drive, with an anticipated completion of spring 2022. The following work is scheduled for the first phase of the project.

### Beginning Monday, May 3:

- Calhoun Road, between North Avenue and Capitol Drive, is scheduled to close through fall by 6 a.m., as crews work to reconstruct the roadway
- Beverly Hills Trail at the intersection of Calhoun Road, is scheduled to close long-term through fall

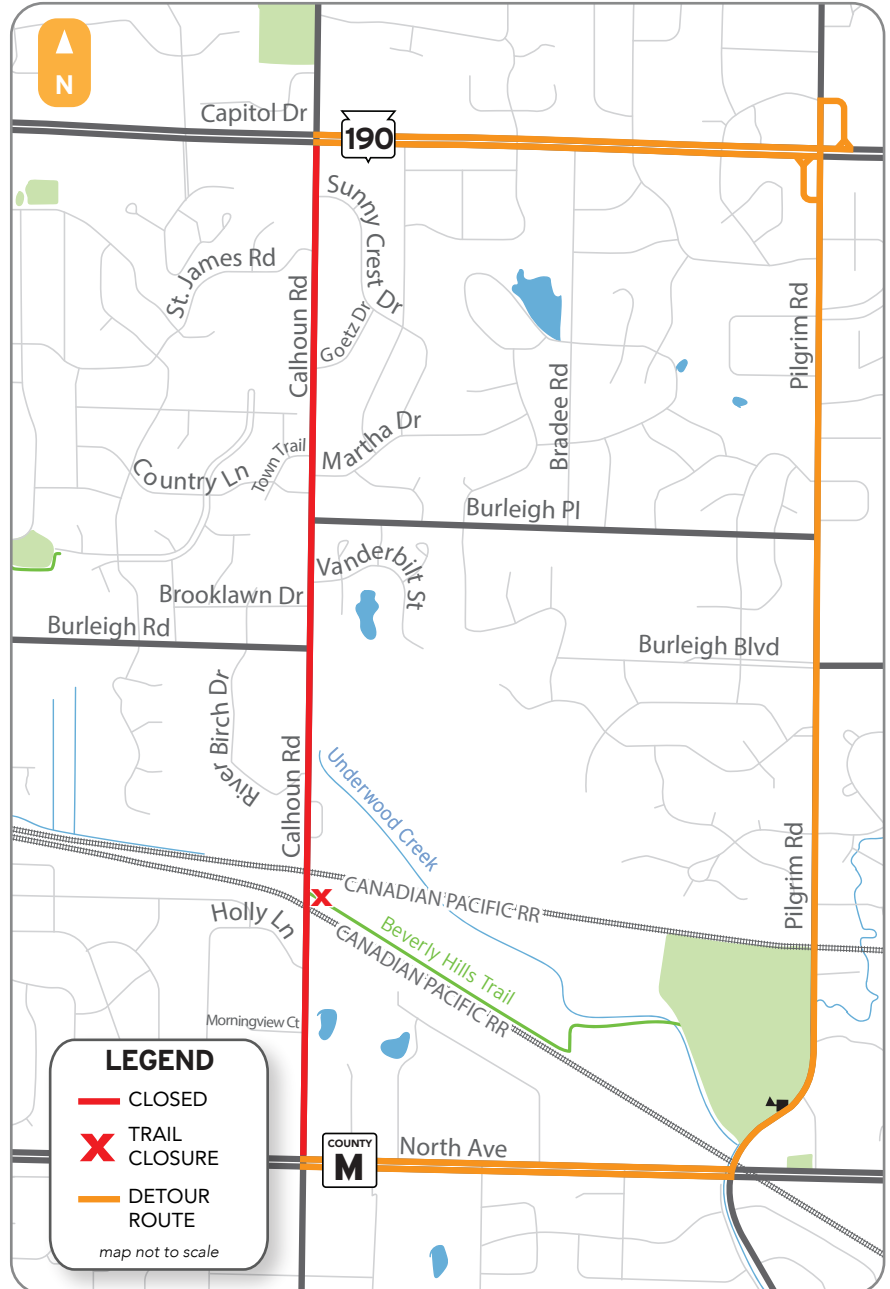
### Detour Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to use North Avenue, Pilgrim Road, and Capitol Drive to get around the closure.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained for the duration of the closure.

Calhoun Road will be closed to thru traffic. Motorists should utilize the posted detour and avoid the work zone, unless their origin or destination is within the project limits.
