

Items ACCEPTED at the Recycle Center

Antifreeze

Mixed with no contaminants.

Appliances

Dishwashers, Washers, Dryers, Microwaves, Water Heaters and Coolers, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Refrigerators, Stoves, Ovens/Ranges, Furnaces.

[Focus on Energy](#) rebates may be available for freezers and refrigerators.

Asphalt, Brick & Concrete

Fairly clean no excess soil or rock. Maximum ½ cubic yard per visit.

Cell Phones

Any brand. No chargers, headsets or cases.

Computers

Currently Brookfield's Recycling Center is not accepting.

Corrugated Cardboard

Flattened - no larger than 2 feet x 3 feet (can also be put out with home recyclables – cut to 3 ft. x 4 ft. & bundle)

Metal – Scrap

Remove all nonmetal materials: this includes aluminum, steel, cast iron, copper, etc. also included are bicycles, fluorescent light fixtures with the ballasts removed, lawn mowers & snow throwers with the gas and oil removed or: call Green for Life (262) 367-6040 for pickup.

Motor Oil & Oil Filters

Not mixed with gas.

Paper Products

Catalogs, cereal boxes, magazines, newspaper, office paper, phone books, etc. (or put in home recycling bin - place in paper bag or bundle)

Rechargeable Batteries

These are not accepted.

Rocks & Stones

Fairly clean, No excess soil. Maximum ½ cubic yard per visit.

Soil

May be sod or contain minimal vegetation. Maximum ½ cubic yard per visit.

TV's, DVD's, VCR's, DVR's

Currently Brookfield's Recycling Center is not accepting.

Wood Ashes

Wood ashes from fireplaces only, must be “cold”.

Yard Waste

- Branches/Brush - Cut to 6 feet or less, up to 30” diameter.
- Grass/Leaves - Must be taken out of bags at recycling center.

Brookfield’s recycle center only accepts recyclable materials. Non-recyclables are not accepted at the recycle center. See the document, [What to do with Non-recyclables](#) for more information on non–recyclables.
