



**Your child is registered to play in one of the
Brookfield Parks & Recreation sport leagues, now what?**

Here's what to expect:

1. Thank you! We look forward to the season.
2. Once the registration period is completed, our staff uses the next two weeks to form the teams.
3. Teams are formed by the school you chose during registration. We form the teams by entry order, using the date and time of your registration. Friend and coach requests are not included in the team formation process.
4. After the teams are formed, the volunteers who offered to coach are contacted and invited to attend a coaches' meeting.
5. If no one on your team offered to volunteer, you will receive a message from our staff seeking volunteers to be the team's coach. We include a copy of the team roster so you can communicate with the other members on the team about sharing the coaching duties.
6. If you do not receive one of these letters/emails, your team has a volunteer coach and they will contact you directly after the coaches meeting. Rosters for teams with coaches are handed out at the coaches meeting.
7. We hold a coaches' meeting to distribute the team rosters, discuss league rules and select a practice time. The volunteer chooses a practice time from a list of available facilities that fits their schedule. We do not assign practices, it is the coach's decision.
8. After the coaches' meeting, the volunteer coach will contact you with the league/team information. We ask them to contact you within (3) days of the meeting; if you haven't heard from them in that time frame, give us a call.
9. Practices begin. Teams practice once a week, sometimes more than once a week depending on the coach and if space allows.
10. Games begin.
