***Resolution approving 2022 Vehicle/Equipment Replacement Fund budget amendment requested by the Police Chief: appropriate \$168,074 to Police vehicle expenditure account 25011562-611000, for purposes of funding police squad purchases and vehicle setup costs budgeted in 2021 but not completed until 2022***

---

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council previously provided budgetary appropriations in 2021 for the acquisition of police squad vehicles and related equipment and setup costs; and

**WHEREAS**, due to delays in the manufacturing of the vehicles in part resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, delivery of certain vehicles and completion of setup of the vehicles by the City's vendor was also delayed and will not be completed until later in 2022, and as such, the previously allocated funding needs to be re-appropriated for the 2022 fiscal year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Brookfield that the following Vehicle Replacement fund budget amendment for 2022 requested by the Police Chief, to provide funding from the Vehicle Replacement Fund to complete the equipping and setup of police squad vehicles budgeted and ordered in 2021, is hereby approved.


