

Reclamite Treatment FAQ:

Why is this product being applied to my road?

Reclamite is a product designed to extend the life of the pavement by 25%, by:

- sealing the pavement surface;
- reducing water penetration that leads to freeze/thaw damage (like raveling + cracking)
- prevents oxidation damage/breakdown of the asphalt material;

What is "Reclamite" made of & is it safe safe?

Reclamite does not release fumes that would cause air pollution. This product is environmentally safe.

Reclamite is an emulsion of petroleum oils and resins that rejuvenates the asphalt, tightens the surface, and restores plasticity. Reclamite is tan in color at the time of application. It turns black as the emulsion breaks and is absorbed into the pavement.

What is the process?

The material is sprayed on by a distributor truck and penetrates into the asphalt in about a half an hour, during which time the street must be closed to traffic. A TEMPORARY application of limestone screening/sand will be applied to the road after the product is sprayed on and is used to absorb any excess material. The sand will be swept up approx.. 2 days later.

How long does the process take?

Once the contractor begins working on your street, the process will only take a few hours.

Once the road has been fully sanded, the road will be **fully** opened to traffic.

How much of a traffic delay will there be?

Delays should be minor and contained to 2 to 3 hours per road/section. Every attempt will be made to keep each affected road open to thru traffic, and flaggers will assist in diverting traffic from one side to the other, as each side is completed. PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY AND FOLLOW ANY SIGNS AND/OR FLAGGER DIRECTIONS.

When can I drive on the road?

You can exit your driveway and drive through the work area at any time after the road is sanded, but please go slow and stay on the sanded area. **Be advised that driving onto a driveway from the roadway before the contractor is finished sanding may cause the driveway and sidewalk to become temporarily stained with Reclamite.**

How can I clean any staining off of my driveway?

You can attempt to clean stains with **"GREEN ALL", "SIMPLE GREEN", or "CITRUS CLEAN"**.

Note: If you opt to "leave it be" on the concrete driveway, it should simply bleach-out over a short period of time with the sun beating on it.

When will the road sand be cleaned up?

The screenings/sand will be swept up a day or two after the product is applied.
