

DID YOU KNOW THAT?

- City ordinance requires that dogs be restrained on leashes whenever on public streets, sidewalks, alleys, public grounds, school grounds, or parks within the City.
- In City parks, dogs are permitted only on parking lots and paved walkways and are not allowed on any grassy areas or trails unless specifically designated.
- Violators are subject to Municipal Ordinance fines.

IN ORDER TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR CITY RESIDENTS TO WALK/EXERCISE THEIR DOGS AS PART OF AN OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL EXPERIENCE, THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION HAS DESIGNATED SPECIAL AREAS WITHIN TWO CITY PARKS WHERE DOGS ARE ALLOWED OFF PAVED AREAS.

Mitchell Park - 19900 River Road
(between Brookfield Rd. and Barker)

- Dog exercise area and trails (see map inside). Dogs are permitted on or off leash (must be under voice control) within the designated area.

Mary Knoll Park - 615 S. Sunnyside
(just south of I-94 near water tower)

- Dogs on leashes only may be walked on grass areas and trails.

To keep your dog safe and be considerate of other park users, please obey the following rules when in any park with your dog:

Control. Dogs must always be under the control of the owner. Do not allow your dog to disturb wildlife or interfere with other park users. Leaving your dog unattended can be dangerous to your dog and other park users.

Prohibited Areas. Dogs are permitted only on parking lots and paved walkways and are not allowed on any grassy areas or trails unless specifically designated.

Clean-up. Dog waste is not only offensive, it can also spread disease and parasites to other dogs and humans. Do not allow your dog to defecate on any property, public or private (except your own property), unless you immediately remove and properly dispose of the waste.

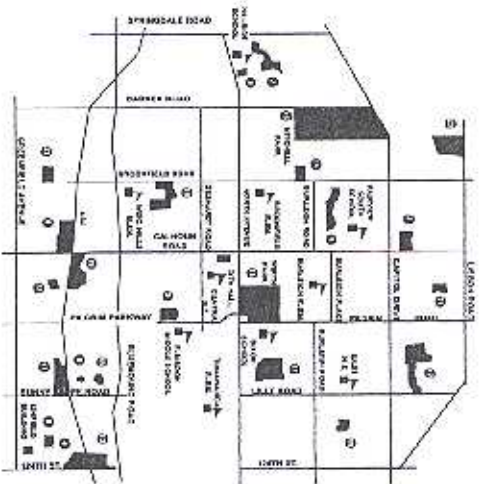
• **ALWAYS** carry equipment sufficient to clean up your dog's feces whenever you and your dog are off your property.

GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS A DOG OWNER

- You must keep your dog's rabies vaccination and dog license current.
- Dogs must wear current rabies, license and owner I.D. tags.
- Keep your dog leashed when off your property.
- Do not allow your dog to trespass on public or private property or run at, bite, unleashed or unattended.
- Prevent your dog from injuring any person, property or other animal.
- Never allow your dog to bark, growl or threaten another person.

Park Rules To Remember

- Motorized vehicles are allowed on designated drives and parking areas only.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in parks except by permit and reservation.
- Dogs and other animals are permitted only on parking lots and paved walks and must be leashed (exception: dogs on leashes may be walked on grass areas at Mary Knoll Park and will be permitted on-leash or off-leash with owner in the designated Dog Exercise Areas at Mitchell Park).

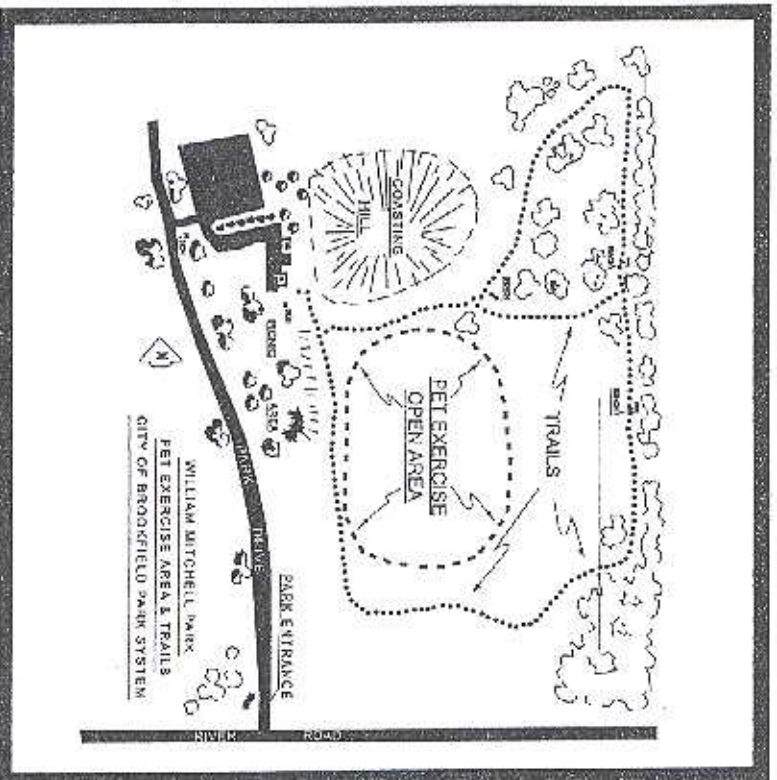
DOG EXERCISE AREA RULES

1. All dogs must be on a leash or under owner supervision and voice command at all times. For the safety of your pet and other users do not leave your pet unattended.
2. Dogs must be licensed, with current rabies vaccination per state law.
3. Pets must wear owner identification tags.
4. Puppies, aggressive dogs, and ferocious dogs must remain on a leash at all times.
5. Do not allow your pet to harass other pets, humans or wildlife.
6. Clean up after your pet immediately. Seal with a plastic bag or use bags provided and dispose in trash receptacles.
7. Leash your pet before leaving the exercise area and remember dogs are not allowed off of paved areas within the remainder of the park.

DOG OWNERS PLEASE REMEMBER THAT YOU WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS AND BEHAVIOR OF YOUR DOG.

THE FUTURE OF THIS EXERCISE AREA DEPENDS ON THE PET OWNERS CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS.

The entrance to the Dog Exercise Area at Mitchell Park is located off of River Road just west of Barker Road in northwest Brookfield.

YOUR PET AND MITCHELL PARK

Dogs and other pets are welcome in the appropriate designated area of Mitchell Park. To keep your pet safe and be considerate to other park users, please obey the Dog Exercise Area rules and the following recommendations.

Your dog must be on a leash or under voice control at all times within the designated dog exercise area.

Wildlife does exist in the Park and your pet does risk encountering a wild animal which could injure your pet. Rabies infection is also a risk when dogs encounter wild animals.

Many of the plants, fungi and water sources in the park may be poisonous to your dog.

As there are no fresh water outlets available bring fresh water for your pets, especially during the hot summer months.

Vegetation may have thorns or seeds that could get tangled in your dog's coat or lodged in your dog's feet, ears or eyes.
