

Mayoral Proclamation

WHEREAS, Brookfield Christian School, 14155 W Burleigh Road, Brookfield, Wisconsin is celebrating its 50th Anniversary on Saturday, May 10, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in 1942, the idea for a Christian School was planted by a single young man, a member of the Milwaukee Christian Reformed Church, now known as Brookfield Christian Reformed Church; and

WHEREAS, in 1958 the Milwaukee Christian School Society formed to begin the process of starting a Christian school and; and

WHEREAS, in 1959 six acres of land, which is the current site of Brookfield Christian School, was purchased; and

WHEREAS, in the fall of 1964, Milwaukee Christian School first opened its doors to 19 students in grades 1 to 8 with 2 teachers and a budget of \$20,000; and


WHEREAS, in 2003 the name was changed from Milwaukee Christian School to Brookfield Christian School; and

WHEREAS, the 2013-14 school year marks the 50th year of operations for the Brookfield Christian School with current enrollment of more than 240 students.
